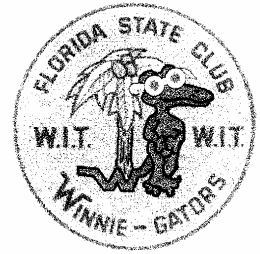

### Orlando, Florida



Once again it's Rally time in Florida as all of the Winnie-Gators and friends are invited to attend the Florida State Rally at the Central Florida Fairgrounds in Orlando, Florida. Our theme this year is "**Fun in the Sun**". Since Florida is the Sunshine state, there should be plenty of sunshine!

The Rally officially begins at 11 a.m. on Thursday, March 8<sup>th</sup> with the Opening Ceremonies. Then, be ready for three nights and four days of jam-packed excitement. Your fee includes: A lunch after opening ceremonies, three catered dinners, a catered breakfast, two continental breakfasts, a wine and cheese party, ice cream social and three nights of entertainment. Vendors' Hall will be filled with bargains and services for your motor home. There will be craft classes, informational seminars, and games with prizes for the winners. Winnebago and Itasca motorhomes will be on display with the latest innovations for you to check out. The craft show has the same categories that are used at GNR. We encourage you to enter your work. Camping includes electricity and buddy water. There are dump stations and bath houses on the Rally grounds.

**Rally Fees:** 1 Coach (2 people) is \$160. 1 Coach (1 person) is \$115. Additional guests over age 6 is \$45 and the early arrival camping fee is \$20 per night. Eastbound from I-4, Exit 75B (Kirkman Road), North; turn Right on Colonial Drive (State Hwy. 50). Westbound from I-4 take Exit 84 West.
