The ceiling in my 2006 Itasca SunCruiser 38T was falling down panel by panel. Every RV repair shop and several upholstery shops either didn't have the experience or wanted an exorbitant amount of money to replace my ceiling.

I was given Wally's information by another repair shop and much to my surprise they had done several before and were very reasonable.

They replaced my entire ceiling including the 2 large slides for just over \$2,000. It looks better than the factory original ceiling! We also had them repair our passenger chair and dashboard.
