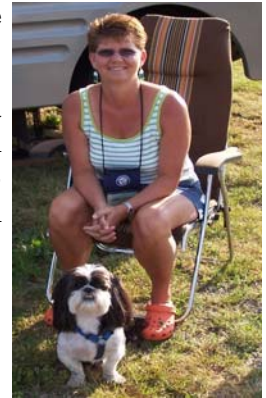
your review. Second, we need to appoint a nominating committee for new state officers and third we need a person to handle the door prizes for the rally next year. Please think about these tasks and volunteer.

In total 23 states were represented, as well as honored guests WIT General Manager Doug Formanek and his wife Pat and our own Eastern Area Representatives Dick and Mikki Dodge. Festivities began with opening ceremonies including posting of colors by the Cypress Creek High School Jr. ROTC of Orlando. Following opening ceremonies everyone enjoyed a catered lunch and margaritas.

Over the weekend rally participants were treated to a variety of activities including seminars, games an ice cream social, a wine and cheese party, and a pet parade. The friendship walk provided
