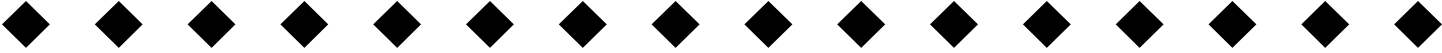

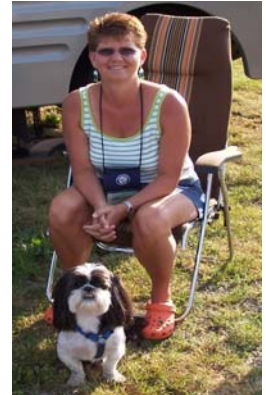

ITEMS OF INTEREST IN THE FORT MYERS AREA

Babcock Ranch Wildlife Tram Tour – Friday, January 16th, 10:00am. 90,000 acre working ranch with cowboys, cattle, wildlife birds and animals. Cost per person \$16.00, tour is 90 minutes. Babcock Ranch is 9 miles from the Civic Center. Maps will be provided. We have reserved trams for our group.

Thomas Edison & Henry Ford Winter Estates

Visit the homes of these famous Americans, as well as laboratory, vintage cars, gracious buildings reminiscent of a bygone era. Guided tours are available.

The Shell Factory & Nature Park

Lots of shops on the grounds, including shells of all kinds, art, jewelry, candles, home decorations, restaurants, etc. There is a nature trail with plants and wildlife from around the world. Waltzing Waters Liquid Fireworks, a water, light, & music production plays at sunset.

Fleamasters Flea Market

900 stores – open Friday – Sunday 8am – 4pm. Stores, produce, food stands, & entertainment.

Beaches
